



# Ethics and Professionalism

## Course Overview:

The *Ethics and Professionalism* online training course discusses the *Code of Ethics* and *Code of Practice* as adopted by the Nova Scotia Institute of Agrolologists. This course will help you understand the ethical responsibilities of Agrolologists and the understanding of the nature of the professional obligations that arise from these Codes.

## Who Should Take the Course?

This course is mandatory for all new members to the Institute, but do not count as Professional Development credits. You should take this course if you have been instructed in your acceptance notification, resulting from your application.

## Course Objectives:

The *Ethics and Professionalism* online training course reviews the application of ethics within the profession of agrolology and the expectations members should meet throughout their career.

## Evaluation Process:

## Course Duration:

This online course is self-paced. The duration will depend on the individual participant and their prior knowledge of the subject matter. On average, the course will take between 30 minutes and 1 hour to complete.
